## **APPLICATION GUIDE**

■ PREPARE THE SURFACE

• Ensure the surface is suitable for Office Films. The surface should be smooth, non-absorbent and clean.

MEASURE & CUT
Measure and cut the film to fit the required area, leaving 2 cm of excess product around each edge.

INSTALLATION
superflex Office Films are self-adhesive, with a removable backing. Only remove the backing when you are ready to install the film, as per the following steps:

- Place the film, without removing the backing, over the surface.
- Starting from one side, remove the backing uniformly along the width of the film, 8-10 cm at a time.
- Use a hard smooth plastic edge to press the adhesive layer firmly to the surface, pushing out any air bubbles.
- Apply the film gently and evenly along the surface, pulling the backing away as you go.
- If you do find an air bubble, peel the material back gently, remove the air bubble and continue.

TRIM TO SIZE

• To create a smooth edge at the end of a surface, use a very sharp knife or blade, and cut at a 45 degree angle, using the edge of the surface as a guide.

JOINTING
To joint the material on a panel or flat surface, apply the first section of film as normal.

- Overlap the second section of film by 3 cm.
- Do not remove the film backing.
- Use a razor or very sharp knife to double-cut through both layers of the film at the centre of the overlap.
- Remove the trimmed material from behind.
- Remove the backing from the second section.
- Use a plastic spatula to push the material back and to push together tightly.

MAINTENANCE
The surface should be maintained as a normal whiteboard surface. Use good quality markers and cleaning fluids, available from supermagnete.
